Plan anchors, not every hour

1. PICK DAILY ANCHORS

Choose one or two moments to reconnect: breakfast, dinner, a show or a set meeting point. Everything else can flex.

2. BUILD CABIN CLUSTERS

Nearby or connecting cabins can matter more than everyone booking the same room type. Think about grandparents, kids and nighttime routines.

3. PROTECT SLEEP

Late shows plus early excursions can wreck the mood by Day 3. Not every person needs every activity.

4. GIVE KIDS INDEPENDENCE

Use Adventure Ocean/teen spaces when they fit your family, and establish exact meeting places/times on big ships.

5. MATCH EXCURSIONS TO MOBILITY

A tour described as “easy” may still involve long piers, stairs, uneven streets or tender boats. Read details carefully.

6. LET PEOPLE SPLIT UP

Grandparents can enjoy a quiet breakfast while kids chase the pool deck. Meet again later. That is a feature, not a failure.
